White Foam Dressing

The White Foam Dressing is a new type of dressing, composed of the latest foam dressing material mixed with medical-grade polyurethane containing carboxymethyl cellulose.



Feature

- Visual Monitoring: Clear visualization of exudate color and volume.
- Tissue Protection: Safeguards delicate structures like tendons and bones.
- Low Adherence: Minimizes pain and trauma during dressing changes.
- Granulation Control: Prevents excessive hyper-granulation tissue formation.
- Graft Security: Bolsters skin grafts without causing shear forces.
- Moisture Balance: Manages heavy drainage while keeping wounds moist.

Application

Exudate Fit: Ideal for moderate to heavy wound drainage.

1. Chronic Ulcers: Treats Stage II-IV pressure, leg, and diabetic ulcers.
2. Surgical Sites: Fits post-op wounds, donor sites, and skin grafts.
3. Burn Care: Manages partial-thickness (second-degree) burns.
4. Secondary Intention: Supports traumatic or deep surgical wounds healing open.
5. Primary Intention: Protects closed surgical incisions and dermatological cuts.
6. Bleeding Control: Safe for mechanically or surgically debrided wounds.
7. Pain & Trauma: Soothes painful wounds, abrasions, lacerations, and cuts.

Feature

- **Moisture Management:** Highly absorbent, effectively managing exudate (wound fluid) and reducing the risk of maceration (softening and breakdown) of the surrounding healthy skin.
- **Moist Healing Environment:** Help maintain an optimal moist environment at the wound surface, which is crucial for promoting faster healing, granulation tissue formation, and epithelialization.
- **Protective Barrier:** The outer layer features a waterproof and bacteria-resistant film that protects the wound from external contamination while allowing gas exchange
- **Cushioning and Insulation:** Provides cushioning to protect the wound from trauma and pressure, and also offers thermal insulation to keep the wound warm, which aids in healing.
- **Versatility:** Available in various shapes, sizes, and thicknesses.



Application

1. **Pressure Ulcers:** Widely used for Stage II-IV pressure injuries and for the prevention of pressure ulcers on bony prominences.

Self Adhesive Foam Dressing

The Self Adhesive Foam Dressing is a highly absorbent, self-adherent wound care dressing. The dressing consists of a polyurethane absorbent foam pad and a polyurethane film layer.

The core of this dressing is an absorbent polyurethane foam layer that vertically wicks wound exudate into the dressing. This absorbent pad retains the exudate within the dressing, preventing it from re-entering the wound and macerating the surrounding skin. The polyurethane film provides an effective barrier and is waterproof, while also allowing for efficient evaporation of exudate, which helps to improve the overall fluid management capabilities of the dressing.

Feature

- **High Absorbency:** Composed of a soft, highly absorbent polyurethane foam pad that locks in a large amount of exudate to prevent maceration of surrounding skin.
- **Moist Healing Environment:** Maintain an optimal moist wound environment, which accelerates the natural healing process and reduces scarring.
- **Cushioning and Conformability:** Provides cushioning to protect the wound from external trauma and conforms well to different body shapes, including bony prominences.
- **Protective Barrier:** Waterproof, breathable film that acts as a barrier to outside contaminants and bacteria.

Application

Suitable for a variety of partial and full-thickness wounds that produce light to heavy exudate, including:

1. Pressure ulcers (bedsores), Stages II to IV
 2. Leg and foot ulcers (venous, diabetic, arterial)
 3. Surgical wounds and incisions
 4. Traumatic wounds, such as skin tears, abrasions, and lacerations
 5. First and second-degree burns
- *Generally not recommended for dry wounds or third-degree burns.
